We did Exciting changes are underway in Croft Street and the surrounding area in Galashiels. We are delivering major upgrade works shaped by your feedback - thanks to a £3 million boost from the UK Government's Community Regeneration Partnership Fund.

Flat roof works are already underway, and we welcomed local tenants and residents to our recent community feedback event to find out how their feedback is shaping further improvements, focusing on safer, greener, and more welcoming spaces.

Key priorities highlighted include new railings, upgraded drying greens, secure cycle and pram storage, new bin enclosures and improved boundaries with timber fencing and planting. Procurement starts this Winter, with work expected to start in January and be complete in Spring 2026.
